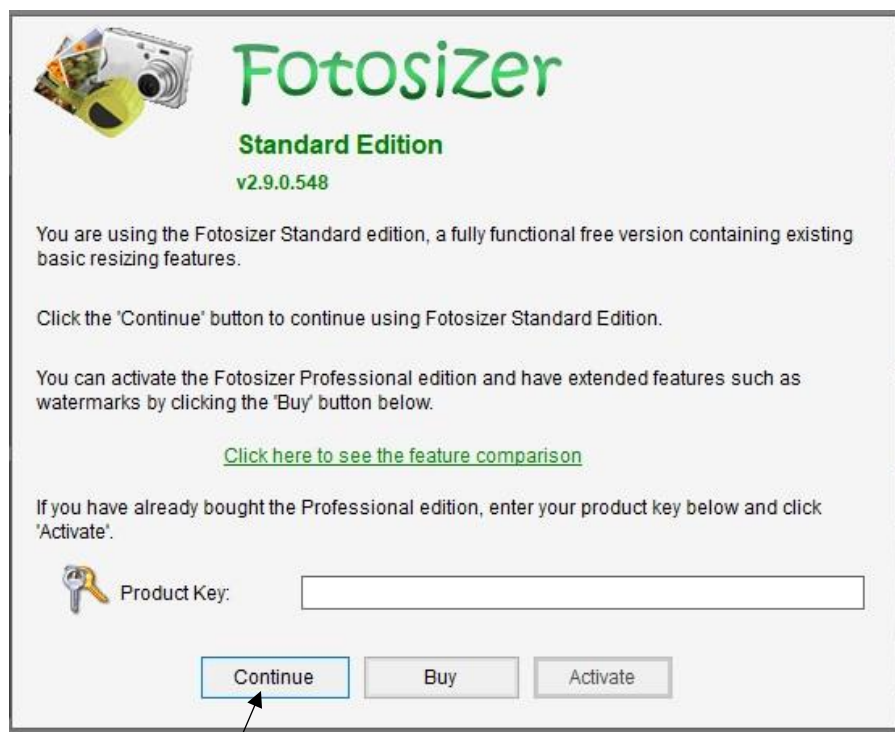


Upon opening the program, the first thing you will see is this on your screen.

Click , “No”



Click, “Continue”



When this comes up, go to “Preset size” and set at 800 x 600. Once you have chosen the size, it will stay for future use.

You are now ready to drag and drop your pictures into Fotosizer. I like to have the pictures I want to resize saved on my Desktop. That way, I can just click and hold on the picture, drag it to Fotosizer and drop it.



Here is my picture I have dropped into Fotosizer.



Now click on the “ Start ” button and let Fotosizer do its thing.



Once Fotosizer is finished, click on the “Open Destination Folder” button. Take note of the place your picture has been sent.

Now click on the “Close” button.



Then click on the “Exit “button. Re- sizing is finished.

The re-sized picture will be labeled “copy “. That is the picture you use in a post.
